

# **GREEN INITIATIVES**

#### Fallow Land Organic Paddy Cultivation in 2 acres.

The most important and prestigious activity of the year 2017-18 was the fallow land paddy cultivation that the NSS unit undertook in two acres. The paddy field had been laid barren for the last twenty years. NSS unit reclaimed the land and cultivated paddy with the assistance of agricultural department. The volunteers got a first-hand experience of paddy cultivation. From preparing the land to harvest, they witnessed various stages involved in the cultivation paddy. The College consider it a great achievement. The percentage of paddy cultivation is becoming less and less every year and the people of Kerala are depending more and more on other states for getting their staple food. NSS unit believe that the fallow land cultivation has given the students positive experiences and examples that would call their attention to this serious problem.





# **Repairing the Check Dam for Irrigation**

The check dam in Kuravilangad Valiyathodu, that had controlled the water supply to the field was in a dilapidated state. The NSS volunteers repaired the damand made it useful for irrigation. The NSS unit was opened a sub-canal 200 meters long to take the water from the check dam to the paddy field.



# HARVESTING OF PADDY

The College had a huge harvest of 3000 kilograms of excellent rice. The students took sickles in their hands and had an experience of harvesting paddy. Farmers of the elder generation shared their experiences and demonstrated before the students the technical aspects of paddy harvesting. The whole event was covered and telecast by Mathrubhumi seeds. 








# CLEANING DRIVE AT COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTRE KOODALLOOR




