## **Module-3 Embroider decorative designs using a combination of stitches and work styles**

**Theory Duration: 3Hr, Practical Duration:3Hr**

Embroidery artwork-Design sample of the embroidered product- select the correct component parts/fabric / material/ tool for embroidery-trace the embroidery design accurately & neatly on the fabric make satin, chain, buttonhole stitches and different types of edges(hem stitch, scallops, lace & rolled hem)-make long and short, shade work, satin and French knot stitches- carry out applique work as per design details- use and combine different hand embroidery techniques to create NM decorative designs
