Feedback Analysis	Action Taken

Students expressed their concern on suitability of getting employment.	Placement cell of the college conducted Bank-test coaching, Additional add-on course 'SEED' started.
Availability of study materials for students from remote areas (areas where net-work connection is poor) should be done effectively.	Xerox copies of the study materials were provided by the Botany department. Google Classrooms were created by all the teachers and materials in the form of PPT and PDF were uploaded. Reprographic facilities for students and staff started.
Lack of facilities for sports and games due to covid-19 pandemic situation requires alternative facilities.	College started online 'Yoga' classes for all the students. You-tube link for the same is given.
