On 28 February 1928, the renowned Indian physicist, Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman discovered the phenomenon of scattering of light, popular as Raman Effect, at the Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science in Kolkata. The discovery by C.V. Raman brought him the Nobel Prize in 1930, the first time for an Indian. To commemorate and honor this event, 28<sup>th</sup> of February was designated as National Science Day, in the year 1986. The day is also observed to recall and celebrate the contribution of all the great scientists of India who made fundamental discoveries and advanced human knowledge.
