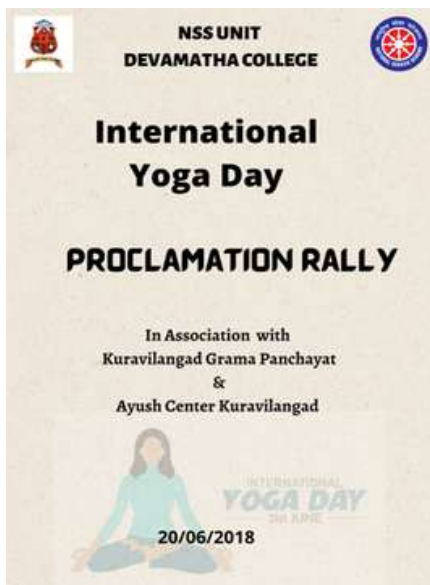

10. KERALA PIRAVI - POSTER DESIGNING & DEBATE COMPETITION

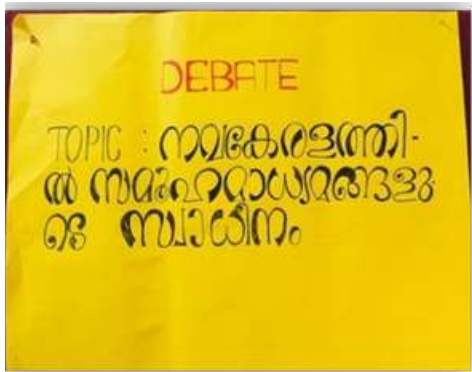

Some of the topics were CCD's, plasma Gravitational waves etc. Students participated in the event actively and active interactive session followed after each presentation. At 1.30 the session dispersed for 30 minutes for lunch which was arranged in the college canteen.

Quiz competitions started at 1.30 pm in the jubilee hall. Prelims were conducted in the morning and five teams were shortlisted. Quiz masters were Vineeth Krishnan and Rony George who are alumni of our college. The quiz was interesting with rapid fire round, buzzer round etc and audience prizes were also given. Treasure Hunt and Photography competitions for students of Deva Matha College began at 11.30 am and the winners were selected.

Students who secured I, II and III places for seminar and Quiz competition were awarded certificates and cash prizes.
