



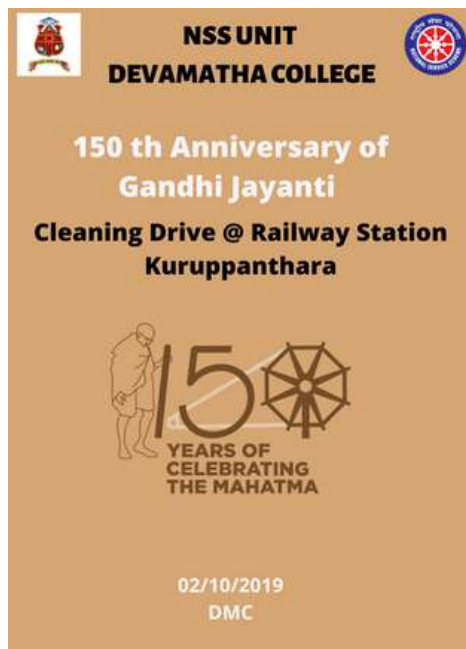
1. 150th ANNIVERSARY OF GANDHI JAYANTI

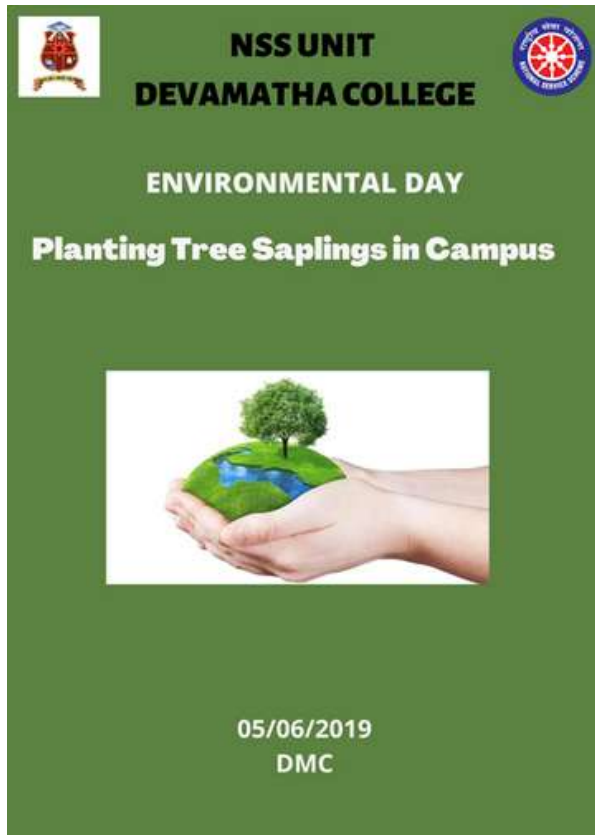
3. ENVIRONMENTAL DAY

The registration for seminar competition started at 09.30 am on 26/2/2020. The inaugural ceremony started at 9.30 am. Prof. K. Indulekha, Professor, School of Pure and Applied Physics, MG University, was the chief guest of the day. Welcome speech was delivered by Dr. Tina Sebastian, Co-ordinator of the program. Presidential address was given by Dr. Saji Augustine. Dr. Jojo K Joseph, principal of the college addressed the gathering. Following the formal inauguration, a talk on "Stellar Messengers and the stories they tell" was given by Prof. K.Indulekha at the e-Learning Centre of Deva Matha College. The talk was attended by the Physics students of our and nearby colleges. A formal vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Sreyas Madhu, the physics association secretary. Inaugural session and talk came to an end by 11.30 am. A tea break followed this session.
