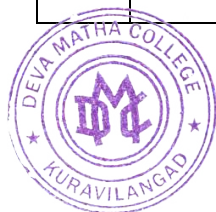

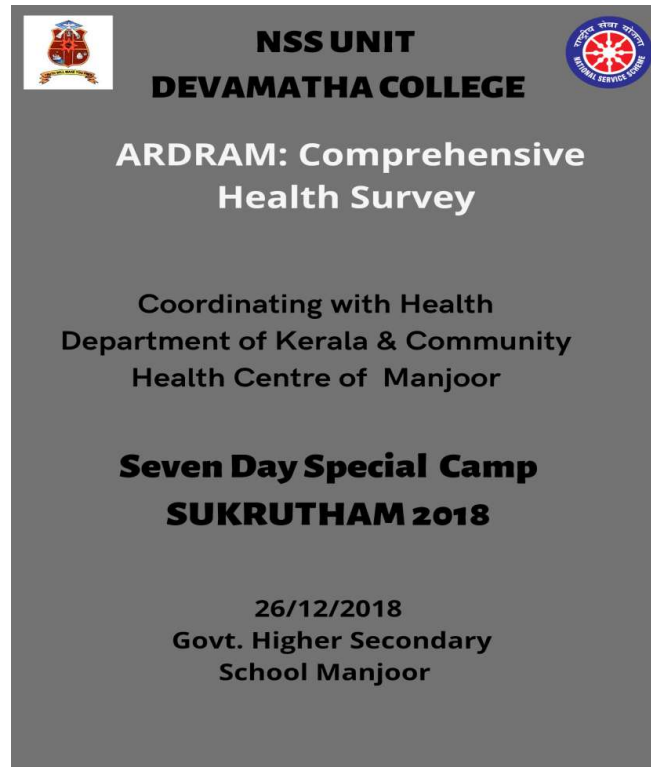

REPORT

As part of the 'Nava Kerala' initiative by the State Government of Kerala which aims at a sustainable development plan for the state aftermath the flood, the Health department of Kerala has come up with a comprehensive health plan titled 'ArDRAM'. The NSS unit of Deva Matha college in association with the Primary Health Centre of Manjoor conducted an elaborate survey in 80 families of ward 14 of Manjoor Grama Panchayath. The survey includes a comprehensive analysis of the domain of health of each individual in the family from diseases to medicines taken. A significant aspect of the survey deals with the waste management facilities employed in the houses. In many houses, the plastic waste was burned and the volunteers gave alternative options to avoid burning. Based on the data from the survey, the concerned officials will have a clear picture on the areas of health needs to be immediately addressed. The volunteers were assisted and guided by the Health Inspectors, Sri. Anil Kumar P. and Shibu K.S. the students while visiting houses as part of the survey, distributed paper carry bags thereby promoting a plastic-free lifestyle. Asha workers accompanied them for guidance. The information collected was compiled in the register provided by PHC.

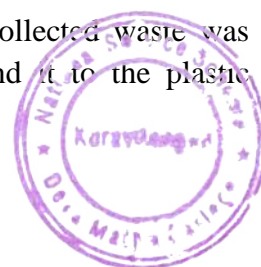

Report

In response to the unprecedented flood that Kerala had to undergo after the torrential rains in August 2018, the NSS unit of Devamatha College opened a Relief Collection Point in the college from August 20-24. The relief materials were collected from faculty, students, alumni and natives. The collected materials were distributed to the following camps on the basis of requirements.

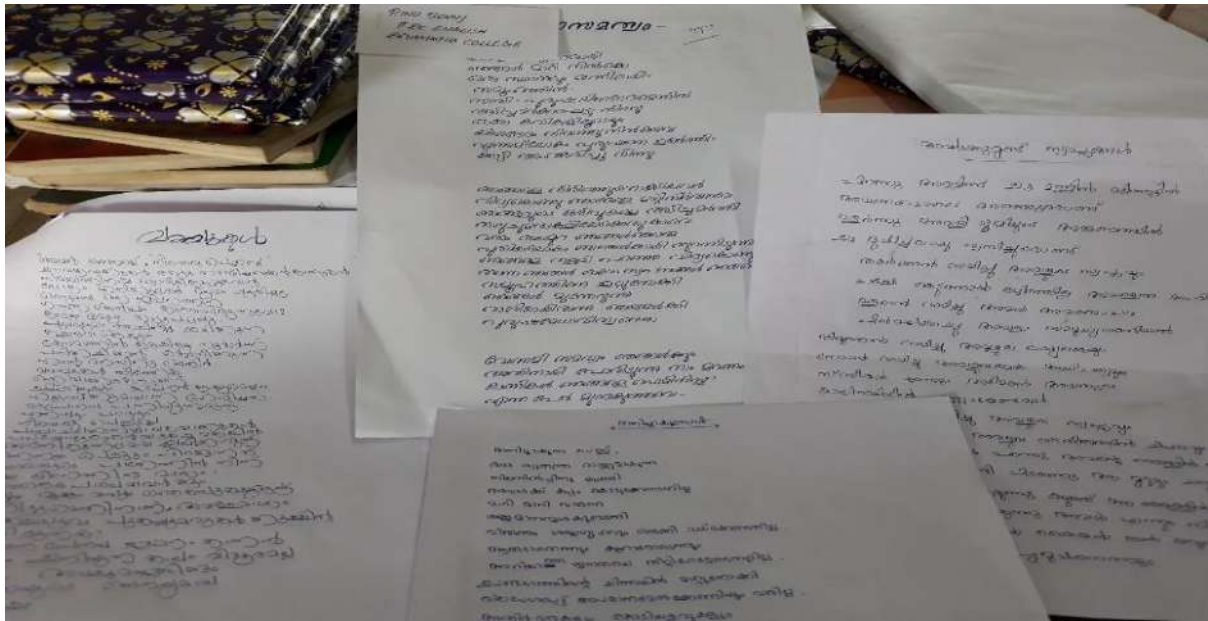




