The district-level NSS office set the questions and contained physical, mental, financial, emotional and social health parameters. Each volunteer surveyed 10 houses following covid protocols. The survey findings were presented in an online meeting, and the answers were compiled in an excel sheet. The report was forwarded to local self-governments for further action.




### REPORT





### **Brief Report**

Gender inequality is a long-term problem in our society and female are discriminated in many ways in the social context of India, although legally women have equal right. Thus, there is a great need to sensitize the society on gender issues so that there would be no discrimination on the basis of gender. Women empowerment through gender sensitization is one of the key criteria to unlock the potential of women. This webinar builds on the experiences we faced and explains the importance of gender sensitization in educational institutions to deal with various gender related issues. It also describes strategies to be adopted in schools to promote gender sensitization. With a view to ensure effective awareness on Protection of Women under Law, Women's health and wellness, Women safety and Mental Health and coping in the Background of Covid-19-challenges that will transform and inspire overall development and empowerment of women, a four day national Webinar on empowerment of women on theme – "Women's Empowerment and Gender Sensitization" was organized by Deva Matha College Women's cell in collaboration with the internal quality Assurance Cell on 18<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> September 2020





### DAY 1 (18th September2020)

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Welcome and Introductory Address by Principal Dr Jojo K Joseph

The principal very warmly welcomed all the participants for being a part of the four day webinar on women's empowerment and gender sensitization. He addressed the various issues faced by women in all walks of life and provided idea of Women Empowerment is empowering the women to take their own decisions for their personal development as well as social development. Empowering women is to make them independent in all aspects from the mind, thoughts, rights, decisions and social or family limitations. The real meaning of the women empowerment is to make them well educated and leave them free so that they can become capable to take their own decisions in any field.

### Day 1(18th September2020)

### Dr.Sisy Jose -Women's health and Wellness

Dr.Sisy Jose has been working in the field of medical and health field for the past 25 years and at present working at Govt. College of Nursing Kottayam. She started her session through a wonderful ppt presentation which was very informative in which she touched various issues related to problem faced by women throughout their lives. She emphasized that women should be happy and satisfied, which is a basic requirement of every human being. Girls' and women's health is in transition and, although some aspects of it have improved substantially in the past few decades, there are still important unmet needs. She spoke about the high stress levels of women due to their dual role of care-takers and career managers. Simultaneously, worldwide priorities in women's health have themselves been changing from a narrow focus on maternal and child health to the broader framework of sexual and reproductive health and to the encompassing concept of women's health, which is founded on a life-course approach. She emphasized on the expanded vision incorporates health challenges that affect women beyond their reproductive years and those that they share with men, but with manifestations and results that affect women disproportionally owing to biological, gender, and other social determinants.

### Day 2: 19September 2020

### Fr.Dr.Davis Panadan CMI : Protection of women under law.

Fr.Dr.Davis Panadan CMI spoke about the Protection of women under law and Important constitutional and legal provisions for women in India The principle of gender equality is enshrined in the Indian Constitution in its Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Fundamental Duties and Directive Principles. The Constitution not only grants equality to women, but also empowers the State to adopt measures of positive discrimination in favour of women. Within the framework of a democratic polity, our laws, development policies, Plans and programmes have aimed at women's advancement in different spheres. India has also ratified various international conventions and human rights instruments committing to secure equal rights of women. He emphasis on **constitutional provisions** The Constitution of India not only grants equality to women but also empowers the State to adopt measures of positive discrimination in favour of women for neutralizing the cumulative socio economic, education and political disadvantages faced by them. Fundamental Rights, among others, ensure equality before the law and equal protection of law; prohibits discrimination against any citizen on grounds of religion, race, caste, sex or place of birth, and guarantee equality of opportunity to all citizens in matters relating to employment.

### Day:3 September 2020 (2.30)

### U. Sreejith (CL of Police) :Women's Safety

U: Srecith spoke about the sexual harassment faced by women in work place, home and college. He gave a talk on sex al harassment faced by women in workplace and college which was very informative. It contained various is charles of kinds of harassment, the types of harassment and the laws related to them. He also informed the participants that if they face any such situations they should inform it to the Internal Complaints Committee, which addresses such issues and anonymity will be maintained. He demonstrates that women and

girls face different forms of harassment – from staring and leering to stalking and sexual assault. Staring and other forms of visual harassment are most common, followed by passing comments, flashing and stalking. Women's safety means a safer, healthier community for everyone. He focused on changing community norms, patterns of social interaction, values, customs and institutions in ways that will significantly improve the quality of life in a community for all of its members.

### Day 4: 21September 2020 (2.30)

### Sr. Amal Jyothi SH :Mental Health and Coping in the Background of COVID - 19

**Sr. Amal Jyothi** addressed the various issues faced by women in mental health. Fear, worry, and stress are normal responses to perceived or real threats, and at times when we are faced with uncertainty or the unknown. So it is normal and understandable that people are experiencing fear in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. She emphasised to the fear of contracting the virus in a pandemic such as COVID-19 are the significant changes to our daily lives as our movements are restricted in support of efforts to contain and slow down the spread of the virus. Faced with new realities of working from home, temporary unemployment, home-schooling of children, and lack of physical contact with other family members, friends and colleagues, it is important that we look after our mental, as well as our physical, health. She provided guidance and advice during the COVID-19 pandemic for students, to help us look after our mental health. She suggested some tips and multiple ways we can support your families and friends cope with stress, and stay mentally healthy or manage our mental health conditions at work. This is especially important during the COVID-19 pandemic. Not only is supporting our families beneficial to the collective performance and relationships at work, but can also promote your own well-being and life satisfaction.


