#### **About KITEX Ltd.**

Kitex garments limited is the business of manufacturing and exporting garments and school bags. Now the company in Kizhakambalam produce only school bags and other garments are imported from their various branches. The company also exports infant and childrens wear and jacket to the US. Kitex garments India is based in Kochi, Kerala. It was incorporated in1992. It made its public issue in the year of1995 it is promoted by BOBY M JACOB, SABU M JACOB and SOMY VARGHESE.

As soon as we reached the company, we are guided by a production officer and he has given a detailed description of their performance. Maximum production in the company is carried out by means of machinery subdivided in various activities like the inception of raw materials, mixing process, making and stitching of bags and then converting it into finished goods. It was great to know that around 2500 bags were produced per day. During school season around 3500 bags were produced per day. In order to make the bags there are mainly four sections, each section contains 150 workers for hand-in-hand work.

The company currently employs over 7000 people at its faculty and has been a business provider to many satellite businesses in the state. The company is the Second largest producer of children's apparel in the world and is now in the process of setting up an operation in the US of AMERICA. Through the years, the company has carved a niche for itself in this highly competitive industry with its tradition of world-class quality.

### **Anna Aluminium Factory**

After visiting Kitex factory, we reached Anna Aluminium factory at 11.25 AM. The company is located at Kizhakambalam, Ernakulam. Anna is active with its affiliated companies associated with thousands of customers & suppliers. Their greatest asset is its brand and its value. Their brand promise is the heart of everything they do and say.

A renowned personality from the Production department also guided us with strict orders. He helped us to learn how the factory works. Anna Aluminium is the biggest manufacturer and marketer of Aluminium products. Anna group places huge emphasis on adherence to quality standards and the ISI mark awarded by the Bureau of Indian Standard to their Aluminium products. Mainly Anna Aluminium manufactures all types of vessels out of them Chkson Cookware, Non-Stic cookware, Induction base vessels, Thermal Cooker, etc. Anna pure aluminium vessels are exported and have 1200 dealers outlet in India.

The founder of Anna Aluminium was Mr. M.C. Jacob. Through his success undertakings, the group conquer the market with high quality Aluminium sheets, Circles, Vessels & Utensils made from 99.95 per cent pure aluminium ingots. The group's turnover has been growing at 20% a year and hopes to maintain the growth rate. Anna group has grown to become the largest Pvt.
