Deva Matha College, Kuravilangad is effectively implementing this programme in different subjects namely Botany, Chemistry, Economics, Physics and Zoology. The Programme has a College level co-ordinator, internal trainers and external trainers. The monitoring committee suggests steps for the improvement of the programme.

The government sanctioned an amount of Rs.1,07,000/- as per the order P4/65679/2019/Coll. Edn. dated 22-06-2019 to conduct the programme this year(2019-2020). The students were selected on the basis of their qualifying examinations. Forty students were selected from first year and another forty from second year. English is a compulsory subject in this year.

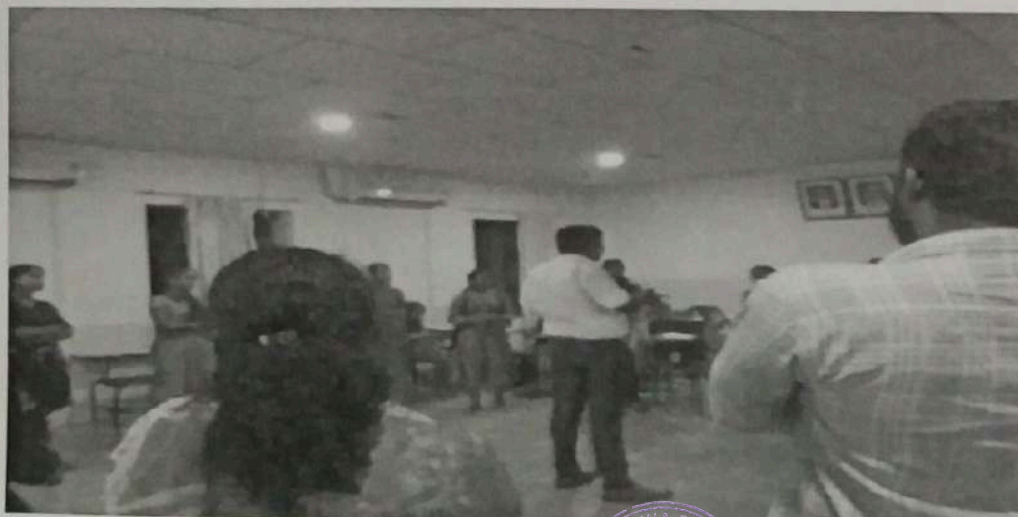

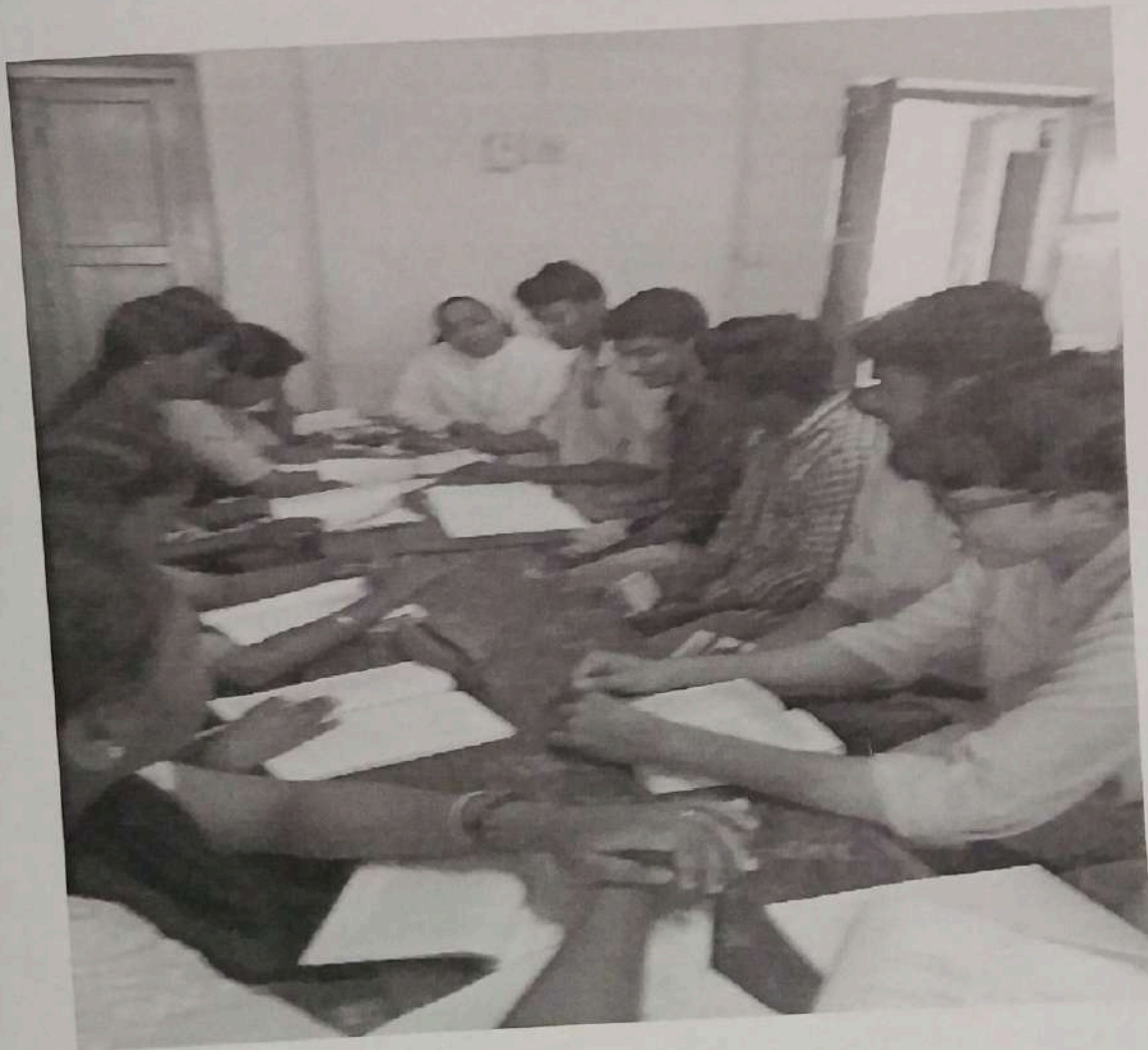

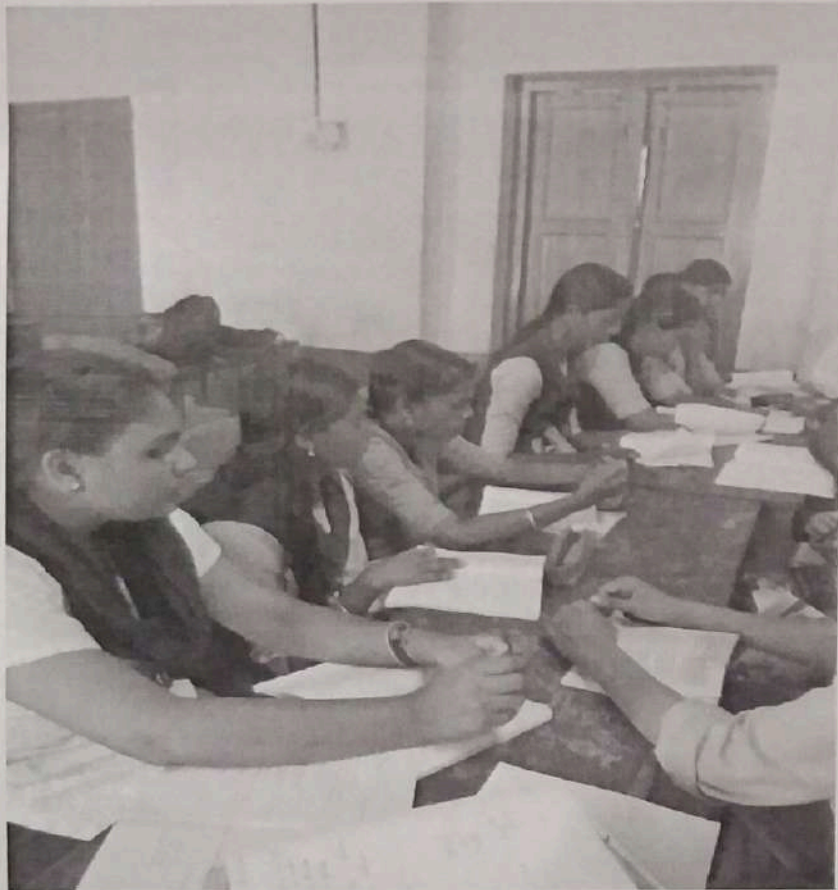
Asap trainer Mr. Ajith P.C took classes on English Language Skills, Learning Skills & Personal Growth.
