



POLICY FOR INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS AND FREESHIPS

Scholarships and freeships are awarded based on need and case-to-case basis to support underprivileged students for their studies. Students belonging to all communities irrespective of caste (or) religion are eligible to apply for scholarships and freeships. Both Day scholars and hostellers are eligible to apply for scholarships and freeships.

1) The college is providing fee concession/ fee waivers for needy students of all Programmes. A standard procedure is followed for the same.

- The students who are intending to avail of this facility have to submit their application in a prescribed format to the head of the department
- The head of the department based on the applicant's academic performance and economic background scrutinizes the application and the same is discussed in the department faculty council.
- The recommendation of the faculty council is forwarded to the Principal by the Head of the department.
- The Principal in consultation with the bursar of the college makes the final approval or rejection of the same.

2) The college is also providing Merit Scholarships for academically excellent students from all the batches and Programmes.

3) College also promotes students to apply for various scholarships and freeships provided by the government and other agencies.

- A staff is given the charge of Scholarships and freeships provided by the government and other agencies.
- The office staff will intimate the Heads of each department regarding the scholarships and freeships.
- The HoDs will inform the same to the class tutors of each batch to intimate the students.
- The students will approach the concerned section in the office to know more about the scholarships.
- The staff in charge of the scholarships and freeships will give more details about the scholarships and collect necessary details from the students.

4) If a student violates any other term and condition of the scholarship/freeship, the same may be suspended or cancelled immediately without further notice.
