To recognize the early signs and symptoms of cancer thus enabling to seek treatment at an early stage, to inform students about the importance of regular screening and check-ups , to inform women aboutmammograms, clinical breast exam and breast self-exam for the early detection of breast cancer and to make them aware of Pap smear tests to check for signs of cervical cancer have also been the objectives of the programme.

Only 52 bodies couldbe recovered, while the remaining 91 missing fishermen were declared dead. The Women's Forum Provided counselling to Okhi affected families who have lost their dear ones to deal with the post-traumatic stress. And also collected data of children who might have required psychological, emotional and psychiatric counselling

The Women's Forum of Deva Matha College Kuravilangad had conducted an Education Promotion for Okhi affected Girls on 13th February 2018. Cyclone Ockhi, which battered Lakshadweep, Tamil Nadu and Kerala on November 29, 2017, before heading towards Gujarat, had killed 143 fishermen in Kerala. Only 52 bodies could be recovered, while the remaining 91 missing fishermen were declared dead. So, Apart from counselling; we closely monitored the situation of families who have lost their bread winners. It has been decided to give top priority to the education of children and the education fund was provided to them with the help of Vienna Malayali Association.
