YOUNG INNOVATORS PROGRAMME - 2021

The YIP is a flagship program of the Kerala Development & Innovation Strategic Council (K-DISC) to promote a culture of innovation among the youth of Kerala. The program is open with an aim to all students studying in class 8 or above across Kerala. This includes School, ITI, Arts and Science, Polytechnic, Medical and Engineering students and also students undertaking research in academics, research and other institutions. The lower age limit shall be 13 and the upper age limit is 35 years. The students undertaking research in the institutions managed by ICAR, the upper age limit shall be 37 years. The details on the themes and participating departments can be found at the end of this document.



Methodology & Approach

K-DISC is excited to announce the opening of the prestigious Young Innovators Programme (YIP) in its fourth edition. Keeping with the true intent of the vision of the program, YIP 2021 is envisioned to be a massive, open, inclusive, collaborative institution-based program aimed at identifying and nurturing young innovators.



As a part of this, the YIP will,

- Identify youth with bright minds for solving real-life problems.
- Provide the expertise, support and connections needed to become impact / business focused entrepreneurs or innovative researchers.
- Give them a better grounding by connecting to research institutions / partner institutions with scholarships.
- Help them build a career around the innovations, researching, re-discovering, incubating and accelerating the innovation.

Exciting prize money for qualifying candidates apart from the project grants.

- Rs 25,000/- each for the district level winner teams.
- Rs 50,000/- each for the State winner teams.

Cash prizes for the top 3 Schools, Colleges, Universities, Research Institutions, Facilitators and Districts have been brought in. Categories with more than 10 entries will qualify for the competition and ideas that qualify for the preliminary evaluation will only be considered. Out of 10 entries at least 2 shall be from the Shelf of Project category. For every 10 entries at least 2 should be from candidates in the marginalised groups (*i.e.* SC/ST or fisherfolk and girls). Your journey in YIP 2021 as an ideator starts with a pre-registration phase and participation will only be teams of at least 2 and up to 5 candidates. Deserving individual candidates with exceptional ideas will also be considered. After that, they will undergo the Voice of Customer & Fundamentals Training. The next phase is where they submit their ideas. They will be having the option to choose projects from a problem shelf or post their ideas. A problem shelf is a list of pre-identified problems identified by a group of experts in the field for which the teams can work and find a solution. The details of their ideas will need to be captured in the idea registration format. Once they submit their ideas it will go through an evaluation process, it will be of multiple levels and at each level, the best teams will be selected and some of them may be asked to rework their ideas and come back to YIP next year.



YIP Tracks

Accelerated Innovation Track: For ideas that can be finished and launched quickly, it enables you to finish your ideas within a year.

Normal Innovation Track: For ideas that may require more than a year to bring to reality.

Rapid Innovation & Hackathon Track: For the winners of ASAP Hackathon programme.

PLAN OF ACTION

- Voice of customer Training during preregistration
- Improved Bootcamp Services with focused support in three tracks
- Practitioners inputs through Community of practices leading to shelf of projects
- Mentoring in five layers Domain, Technology, Business plan, Intellectual property and prototyping
- Outcome is priority based on time, resources, impact.
- Apart from Accelerated Innovation Track and Normal Innovation Track, a Rapid Innovation Track around a design hackathon and rapid prototyping is attempted.

PREVIOUS EDITIONS

YIP 2021 is the fourth edition of the program. The first edition started in 2018 and is reaching the closing stage. The next two editions, started in 2019 and 2020 are currently in progress.

YIP 2020-23: The 2020-23 YIP program was officially launched in July 2020. Though the pandemic has delayed it, the program has picked its pace in no time. Nearly 3000 teams were registered for the program and 800 teams passed the initial stage and 234 teams passed the second level and will be contesting at the state level.

YIP 2019-22: Launched in May 2019, the second edition of YIP, 370 candidates in 102 groups passed the multi-level screening processes, covering 11 themes. This track deals with inter-disciplinary issues or problems which require a multi-faceted approach to find implementable solutions. It also includes socially relevant issues which may require intervention in the form of a social enterprise or impact solution.

YIP 2018-21: The programme commenced in Mar 2018 and, among 203 selected candidates, a scholarship of Rs 2,72,000/- has been granted to 9 selected mentees through an Accelerated Innovation Track Challenge in 2019. The evaluation of the Normal Innovation Challenge 2019 has concluded, and 11 mentees got selected.
