



On 28 February 1928, the renowned Indian physicist, Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman discovered the phenomenon of scattering of light, popular as Raman Effect, at the Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science in Kolkata. The discovery by C.V. Raman brought him the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930. To commemorate and honour this event, 28<sup>th</sup> of February was designated as National Science Day, in the year 1986. 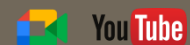
